The [Trustees Files Index 1889-1929](#) is now available on the QSA website. This index lists names from [Series 15502](#): Files Re Trustees under the Trustees Act of 1889. The files came from the ecclesiastical jurisdiction of the Southern District of the Supreme Court of Queensland and include trusts from before 1889 which were still being administered.
