QSA [Item ID18165](#) includes general correspondence relating to the hospitalisation of patients at Roma and Dalby sanatoriums including correspondence about the establishment of the Jubilee Sanatorium at Dalby, and deals with patients at the Dalby and Roma sanatoriums.

Series of Interest

QSA [Series ID 18031](#): Petitions 1901-1966

This series consists of petitions made to the Supreme Court, Southern District of Brisbane relating to various Acts including the Companies, Electoral and Mental Health Acts. There is information about creditors seeking to wind up companies, regulation of charitable trusts, marriage settlements, election to the Legislative Assembly and deceased estates.
