Three new indexes on dentists have been added to our website. The [Index to Dentists 1903-1932](#) and [Index to the Dental Board 1910-1932](#) indexes correspondence and documents on registration of dentists by the Dental Board.

The [Index to Dentists Apprentices 1903-1925](#) indexes files on individual dentists who had difficulty in obtaining recognition by the Dental Board.

Images on ArchivesSearch

Among the wonderful images available on the ArchivesSearch catalogue are photographs from [QSA Item ID 392337](#), an album of photographs taken in the early 1930s.

The album includes photographs from the Sunshine Coast, Cooloola, Burnett, Redcliffe and Gold Coast and hinterland regions. Images from the collection include [passengers arriving for the Railway Picnic at Nielson Park, Burnett Shire](#) and [Surf Lifesavers at Maroochydore](#).

Series of interest

The [Register of Medical Practitioners 1860-1973, Series ID 18608](#) is a record of names for medical practitioners who were registered by the Medical Board of Queensland. Entry details vary over time but generally include the certificate number, date of registration with the name, address and qualifications of the practitioner.

There is also a separate register of interns 1955 -1973. The first page of the volume 1860 - 1908 has a list of "legally qualified medical practitioners under certificate to the Medical Board of New South Wales who were residing in the colony prior to formation of the 'Queensland Board'".
